### **Purpose**

Essential tool designed for use in testing for leaks on the EGR cooler utilizing air pressure and water.

### Application(s)

2015 Navistar® N13 (EPA 10)

#### Instructions

#### **Tool Installation**

- 1. Bring vehicle into shop and park vehicle on flat surface with wheels straight ahead
- 2. Shift transmission to Park or Neutral and set parking brake.
- 3. Install wheel chocks.
- 4. Unlatch and open hood.
- 5. Remove EGR cooler from vehicle. Refer to appropriate engine service manual, service bulletin, or equivalent for detailed instruction. Place EGR cooler on bench.




Figure 2. EGR Cooler Supply and Return Lines / Harness.

- 1. EGR cooler gas outlet hose
- 2. EGR valve return and deaeration fitting
- 3. EGR valve harness
- 4. EGR valve supply
- 6. Remove EGR cooler gas outlet hose (Figure 2, Item 1), EGR valve return lines, deaeration fitting, and if necessary, EGR valve harness (Figure 2, Items 2 and 3). Refer to appropriate engine service manual, service bulletin, or equivalent for detailed instruction.
- 7. Remove EGR valve supply (Figure 2, Item 4).



- 1. Exhaust gas inlet adapter
- 8. Install exhaust gas inlet adapter (Figure 3, Item 1) into EGR cooler exhaust gas inlet port. Tighten knurled ring to seal.

Figure 4. 12-892-07-03 Main Cab Heat Plug.

- 1. Main cab heat plug
- 9. Align and install main cab heat plug (Figure 4, Item 1) into EGR cooler main cab heat port. Tighten knurled knob to seal.

Figure 5. 12-892-07-06 Coolant Inlet Block-Off.


- 1. Coolant inlet block-off
- 10. Align and install coolant inlet block-off (Figure 5, Item 1) into EGR cooler coolant inlet port. Tighten knurled knobs to seal.

- 1. EGR valve supply adapter
- 11. Align and install EGR valve supply adapter (Figure 6, Item 1) into EGR valve supply port.

Figure 7. 12-892-07-05 Sleeper Cab Heat Block-Off.

- 1. Sleeper cab heat block-off
- 12. If vehicle is equipped with bunk heater, remove bunk heater port connector from port. Align and install sleeper cab heat block-off (Figure 7, Item 1). Tighten knurled knob to seal.





Figure 8. Rear Pressure Test Adapters.

- 1. 12-892-07-01 Exhaust Gas Output Plug
- 2. 12-892-07-10 EGR Valve Return, Degas, and Coolant Filter Supply Plugs (3)
- 3. 12-892-07-07 Coolant Outlet Clamp Assembly
- 4. Coolant outlet clamp assembly knurled knob
- 13. Align and install exhaust gas outlet plug (Figure 8, Item 1) into EGR cooler exhaust gas outlet port. Tighten knurled ring to seal.
- 14. Align and install plugs (Figure 8, Item 2).


15. Align and install coolant outlet clamp assembly (Figure 8, Item 4) into EGR cooler coolant return port. Tighten knurled knob to seal (Figure 8, Item 3).

Figure 9. Bubble Test Hose Assembly.

- 1. 12-892-07-04 Bubble Test Hose Assembly
- 16. Install bubble test hose assembly (Figure 9, Item 1) to EGR valve supply adapter.
- 17. Place end of bubble test hose into beaker of water.

Figure 10. Regulator Assembly.

- 1. 12-892-07-08 Regulator Assembly
- 2. Exhaust gas output plug
- 18. Install regulator (Figure 10, Item 1) to plug (Figure 10, Item 2).
- 19. Perform pressure test. Refer to appropriate service manual, service bulletin, or equivalent for detailed instruction.

#### Tool Removal

- 1. Remove regulator (Figure 10, Item 1) from plug.
- Remove bubble test hose assembly (Figure 9, Item 1) from EGR valve supply adapter.
- 3. Remove coolant outlet clamp assembly (Figure 8, Item 4) from EGR cooler coolant return port.
- 4. Remove block-off plugs (Figure 8, Item 2).
- 5. Remove exhaust gas outlet plug (Figure 8, Item 1) from EGR cooler exhaust gas outlet port.
- 6. If vehicle is equipped with bunk heater, remove sleeper cab heat block-off (Figure 7, Item 1). Install bunk heater port connector to port.
- 7. Remove exhaust gas inlet adapter (Figure 3, Item 1) from EGR cooler exhaust gas inlet port.
- 8. Remove EGR valve supply adapter (Figure 6, Item 1) from EGR valve supply port.
- 9. Remove coolant inlet block-off (Figure 5, Item 1) from EGR cooler coolant inlet port.
- 10. Remove main cab heat plug (Figure 4, Item 1) from EGR cooler main cab heat port.
- 11. Install EGR valve return line, deaeration fitting, EGR cooler gas outlet hose, and if necessary, EGR valve harness (Figure 2, Items 1 4). Refer to appropriate engine service manual, service bulletin, or equivalent for detailed instruction.
- 12. Install EGR cooler into vehicle. Refer to appropriate engine service manual, service bulletin, or equivalent for detailed instruction.
- 13. Close and latch hood.
- 14. Remove wheel chocks.
