NOTE: Please reference International® Service Portal^{sм} regarding any possible revisions to this document.

- 1. Park vehicle on flat surface.
- 2. Shift transmission into Park or Neutral and set parking brake.
- 3. Turn ignition to Key OFF position.
- 4. Install wheel chocks.
- 5. Access and remove rear crankshaft oil seal. Discard seal. Refer to appropriate Service Manual for detailed instructions.
- 6. Install new rear crankshaft oil seal and complete service procedure as indicated in appropriate Service Manual.
- 7. Remove wheel chocks.

Care and Maintenance

- · Keep tools clean and free of contaminants
- · Replace any damaged components
