Purpose

The lift assembly is used to disassemble high-voltage battery stacks as well as to lift and move individual battery packs.

(1.5 m) long, to safely push someone away from the vehicle if they accidentally come in contact.

WARNING: To prevent personal injury and / or death, remove all jewelry such as watches, necklaces, and earrings. Remove all metal objects that are conductors of electricity.

WARNING: To prevent personal injury and / or death, or damage to property, inspect tool for wear / damage prior to use. Replace any worn or damaged components as necessary.
